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

FULL DAY HANOI CITY TOUR

THE TOUR RUNS DAILY

8:30: Our car and tour guide are ready at your hotel for Hanoi city. Firstly, we will visit Ho Chi Minh Complex with Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, his house on stilt, the botanical garden and the Presidential Palace while learning about his life and revolutionary activities. This used to be the residence of the Governor of Indochina. After 1954 it was named the Presidential Palace and became the place where Ho Chi Minh lived and worked until he passed away in 1969.

On the way out visit One Pillar Pagoda. The pagoda was constructed in 1049 by King Ly Thai Tong according to his dream of Bodhisattva sitting on a lotus flower and led him to the pagoda. In 1954, the pagoda was destroyed by the French before their withdrawal. After taking over the city on October 10th 1954, Vietnam Ministry of Culture restored the pagoda. The pagoda of today remains since this restoration.

Around 11:00: Arrive at the Temple of Literature. This is the combination of the Confucius Temple worshipping Confucius which was built in 1070 and the first Royal National university in Vietnam built 6 years later in 1076. Considered as "an escape" from the bustling city, this temple and its beautiful garden provide an opportunity to learn more about education in Vietnam since 1000 years ago until recent history.

12:00: Enjoy lunch with Vietnamese cuisines.

13:00: Continue to visit the interesting Ethnology Museum. Located west of the city center, this museum offers informative and well-documented display on the country's 54 ethnic groups, include elaborate and colorful hill-tribe costumes, weaving designs, musical instruments, fishing

implements, work tools and other functional objects. The display continues on to the garden outside with fascinating examples of minority housing from the King's to the ones of the ethnic groups in Central Highlands.

16:00: Take 1 hour-cyclo tour around Hoan Kiem Lake (Restored Sword Lake) and the Old Quarter through its streets, that are named after the guilds that used to represent such as Hang Bac (Silver Street), Hang Gai (Silk Street), Hang Tre (Bamboo Street), ...

17:00: Return to hotel. Finish an unforgettable full-day Hanoi sightseeing!

OVERVIEW

Our professional local guide will help you experience this great tour.

The old quarter in Hanoi is over a thousand years old, and today it retains much of the old flavor that made the area special in earlier times. Each street was the exclusive domain of one trade (guild), so there are whole streets of blacksmiths, silver shops, paper shops, headstone makers, and more. Originally, there were just 36 streets in the old quarter, but today there are more than 50, although many of the streets are short and the area is rather compact.

It is very difficult to find some local food on your own in hidden alleys or sidewalks; certainly the best way to make it easy is to join us on this special tour to learn about Vietnamese cuisine, culture, people, and language. After all, a Hanoi street food tour will give you a unique opportunity to try the foods of the local Hanoi people. We ensure the food is handled hygienically and provide a comfortable venue for the tastings. The benefit also goes back to the vendors, restaurants, or families as we buy directly from them.

Note: The Vietnamese Street Foot Tour is focusing on street food stalls as well as lovely mini restaurants (not luxury restaurants), and certainly these are experienced and appreciated by our local experts every day. You'll keep ordering food as long as you keep eating. The suggestion is that you should taste a little bit of everything and enjoy every bite.

FULL DAY TO HOA LU - TAM COC

📖 Overview

Escape the bustling confines of Hanoi city and breath the fresh air on this full-day rural Vietnam tour. Just a 2-hour drive from Hanoi, Ninh Binh is surrounded by a stunning landscape of lush green paddy fields and striking limestone outcrops.

Hoa Lu-the remains are the temples dedicated to King Dinh and King Le, the two heroes who lived in the 10th century and chose Hoa Lu to build the citadel of the capital city (from 968 to 1009). Tam Coc, which means three caves, is considered "Halong Bay on land" and is created by the Ngo Dong River through mountains.

ITINERARY

8:00: Our driver and tour guide will pick you up from your hotel for a 2-hour drive to Ninh Binh.

10:30: Arrive at Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam. In 968, a local warlord named Dinh Bo Linh declared himself king and was known as King Dinh Tien Hoang. Hoa Lu became the capital and political, economic, and cultural center for the next 41 years (968-1009) of Dai Co Viet, which was how Vietnam was called at that time. Twelve of these were under the Dinh dynasty. And 29 years later, under the Le dynasty of King Le Dai Hanh. In 1010, King Ly Thai To had moved the capital from Hoa Lu to Thang Long - present day Hanoi. Hoa Lu thus became the former citadel. There are now two temples built on the grounds of the old royal palace. One is dedicated to King Dinh Tien Hoang, and the other is to King Le Dai Hanh. The visit offers a chance to learn more about the feudal dynasties and historical periods in Vietnamese history.

12:00: Depart Hoa Lu for Tam Coc. Enjoy lunch in Tam Coc at a local restaurant (please let us

know in advance if you are a vegetarian or have special dietary requirements) - goat meat dishes are the local specialty.

After lunch, we take a 5-minute walk to the boat station, and then enjoy a lovely 2-hour boat trip to visit Tam Coc. Known as "Halong Bay on land", Tam Coc has three limestone caves stretching along the Ngo Dong river. The boat trip will take you on a relaxing journey along the river with stunning views of the limestone mountains, rice paddies, and temple sites from Hang Ca (the first cave) to Hang Hai (the second cave) and Hang Ba (the third cave).

Depart Tam Coc and drive back to Hanoi. Arriving back in Hanoi at around 18:00 after an unforgettable day.

OVERVIEW

Escape the bustling confines of Hanoi city and breath the fresh air on this full-day rural Vietnam tour.

Just a 2-hour drive from Hanoi, Ninh Binh is surrounded by a stunning landscape of lush green paddy fields and striking limestone outcrops.

Hoa Lu - the remains are the temples dedicated to King Dinh and King Le, the two heroes who lived in the 10th century and chose Hoa Lu to build the citadel of the capital city (from 968 to 1009).

Trang An was recently recognized a UNESCO World Heritage Centre. This stunning ecosystem, studded with impressive karsts and carved with winding rivers and mystical caves, is also home to some fascinating temples and sites of cultural and historical importance.

After lunch, take the amazing boat trip to visit Trang An grottoes, which is a gathering of 31 valleys and 50 cross-water caves and home to 600 kinds of flora and over 200 kinds of fauna, many of them in the Red Book of Vietnam. Here, you will board a sampan (a small traditional wooden boat) and take a boat ride through the rich and diverse landscape along the glassy rivers dotted with lotus flowers and through the caves which have been etched out of the staggering karsts.

While rowing through Trang An grotto in the quiet, fresh air of the highlands, with only the sound of birds and the oars stirring the clear water and surrounded by magnificent forested mountains upon which graze white goats, visitors enjoy a heaven on earth. At the end of the day, drive back to Hanoi at 16:00 and arrive in Hanoi at 18:30 hrs after an unforgettable day.

OVERVIEW

Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is known for its emerald waters and thousands of towering limestone islands topped by rainforests with breathtaking scenery that is both mystical and magnificent. The Bay is located in the Gulf of Tonkin and, with nearly 2,000 islands and islets forming a spectacular seascape of limestone pillars, is recognized as one of the most beautiful bays in the world.

ITINERARY

* 4-hour boat trip:

9:00: Get pick up from your hotel for a 2.5 hour drive via new Express way to Tuan Chau International Port.

11:45: Arrive at the harbor, and get onboard your private boat. The boat sails into the Bay while lunch is served. Enjoy 4-hour journey through a maze of islets amid dramatic natural scenery, visit Thien Cung Grottoes Cave, Dinh Huong islet, Cock fighting islets.

16:00: Disembark the boat and return Hanoi via new expressway.
